Parental/Carer's, permission for the use of photographs and/or video Images.

1. Parents/Carers are permitted to take their own photographs/video of their child participating in matches or training; providing they have given their consent. Parents/Carers are advised that such imagery may contain other participants due to the nature of the activities.
2. By signing the Player Profile Form parents are agreeing to the above. The **Club** and the Parents/Carers understand that this includes the above unless they indicate otherwise.
3. Parents/Carers are encouraged to report any person taking photographs who does not seem to be associated with the **Club** to any Coach, Manager or Club Official. Please be considerate if you are challenged by a Coach, Manager or Club Official.
4. Concerns including inappropriate or intrusive photography is reported to the Club Welfare Officer and recorded in the same manner as any other child protection and safeguarding concern.
5. Coaches may need to use Video Equipment as a legitimate coaching aid. Images will be used appropriately for the purpose they were collected for.
6. Pictures or images taken by the **Club** may also be used for the promotion of the **Club**, for education or publicity purposes. We will ask for parental/carer's permission to use their child's image and wherever possible show the image to the parents and child in advance. This ensures that they are aware of the way the image will be used.
7. Only images of children in appropriate kit (training or competition), will be used to reduce the risk of inappropriate use, and to provide positive images of the children.
8. Coaches, managers and club officials will be made aware if consent has not been given for a particular child so that images or video are not taken of that particular child.
9. Children will be advised should a person plan to take photographs or film their activities.
10. Children will be advised that should they have concerns they can report these to the coach, manager or other Club Official.
11. Where a photograph is in the public domain, no child's name will be associated with any such photograph. All photographs and video taken by the **Club** will be stored in a responsible manner, and disposed of when no longer required.
12. A Parent/Carer can request the permanent removal and destruction of any images or video of their child at any time.
13. Players and members over the age of 18 (adults) are photographed and filmed in line with the consent given during the player profile registration.

Hastings & St Leonards Priory Cricket Club's Policy for Transport to Matches and Practice Sessions

1. The **Club** aims to provide seasonal planned away fixtures and competitions to parents/carers with an opportunity to make appropriate arrangements.
2. Parents/Carers provide permission for their child to participate in competitions, away fixtures and events through the player profile and by delivering their child to the relevant event.
3. Parents/Carers are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of their child for matches or training.
4. It is not the responsibility of the coaches or managers to transport, or arrange to transport, children to and from any training or match.
5. Coaches and Managers will be responsible for the children in their care when at matches or training.
6. Parents/Carers must ensure they deliver/collect their children promptly and at an appropriate time in relation to any match or training session. In the event of a parent being unable to deliver their child as previously agreed with any coach/ manager to an event, or if they are prevented from collecting their child as anticipated, they must inform the relevant coach/ manager at the earliest opportunity.
7. Repeated late collection of a child will result in the Club Welfare Officer being informed of the circumstances.
8. Parents/Carers are encouraged to remain at matches and training sessions to support their children.

Hastings & St Leonards Priory Cricket Club's Changing Policy

The following policy applies to all adults and **players under the age of 18**:

1. No pressure should be placed on children to change or shower at any match or training session, and generally are encouraged to change and shower at home.
2. Adults must not change, or shower, at the same time using the same facility as children - if the same changing room is used then they must have different times.
3. If adults and children need to share a changing facility, they must do so at different times.
4. Mixed gender teams have access to and must use separate male and female changing rooms.
5. Individual parents should not enter changing rooms when children are changing or showering.
6. At some venues used by the **Club**, other groups, including adults, may be using the facility for a number of sports or activities. Consequently any changing facilities may be used by a variety of age groups over whom the **Club** has no control or influence.
7. Parents/Carers will be informed where this is the case, and at these venues children should change at home before and after the event. The **Club** cannot be responsible for any child who chooses to use such a changing facility either with or without parental consent.
8. **Mobile phones must be SWITCHED OFF and not used in changing rooms.**
